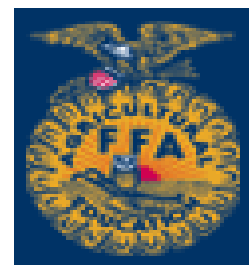

- Sheep Market Class: Minimum weight change to 110 lb.
- Pigs, Goats & Sheep will need to weigh in by 10:00pm on Wednesday
- Poultry show moved to Friday at 10:00am
- New scales hours open from 4pm – 10pm
- Special Needs Livestock Show – TBD – following Round Robin – Lower Barn Show Ring
- **NO Water** dumped in walking areas please...PLEASE find a grassy spot or a drain!
- **NO FITTING** will take place in the lower barn on the South end, please use the North end of the barn for all fitting work.
- **NO INJECTIONS/DRUG** use will be tolerated by the Monroe County Fair board.
